Discussion Questions

- How early in the book did you discover who Millie was? Or where the twins were in the autumn of 1888, and the consequence of that time?
- At thirty-eight years old, what was your greatest accomplishment?
- Do you think you could have survived on the streets of London with only the clothes on your back?
- Did you think the time periods were accurately portrayed? Was there too much detail/not enough/just right?
- Which character or moment prompted the strongest emotional reaction for you? Why?
- If you could talk to the author, what burning question would you want to ask?
- What surprised you most about the book? Why?
- Were there significant plot twists and turns? If so, what were they?
- What do you think will happen next to the main characters?
- Would you continue the journey through time by reading the next book in the trilogy (Running out of Time)?
