

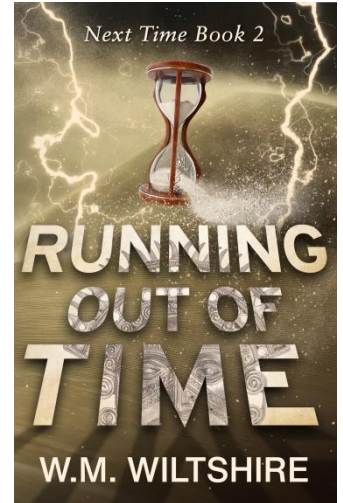
RUNNING OUT OF TIME

Discussion Questions

- Looking at the cover, did you find the hidden image? Do you know what it represents? What is the significance of the timepiece on the cover?
- How would you describe the Puritan way of life in the 17th century?
- How could such well-educated gentlemen believe in the ranting and antics of those young women without questioning their rationality?
- During the train derailment recovery/rescue efforts, would you have been able to volunteer your services to help those less fortunate? What could you have done?
- Cave diving can be very claustrophobic and a bit scary, too. You can't just pop your head above water to get your bearings. And stirring up ground silt can make visibility nearly impossible. Have you ever tried something that has taken you out of your comfort-zone?
- Do you think you could have survived in that glade in the forest? Could you build a shelter, make tools, and catch food. If you were stranded in the woods, could you survive?
- Did you think the time periods were accurately portrayed? Was there too much detail/not enough/just right?
- How did you feel about the ending? How might you change it?
- If you could talk to the author, what burning question would you want to ask?
